
# Understanding Inequality through Participatory Activities & Discussions

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- 1) Lesson Title: Law of Survival
- 2) Lesson Information (Subject, Unit, Grade Level, Format, etc.):
  - Subject & Unit: Social Studies (1st Semester)
  - Grade Level: Grade 6
  - Unit 2. Korea's Economic Development (2) Korea's Economic Growth
  - Format: Event-based Learning
- 3) Lesson Goals: Students can understand and sympathize with the socially disadvantaged and the discriminatory situations they face through role-playing.

#### 4) Prior Activities:

- 1.(Korean-Whole Book Reading) Have a discussion on meritocracy as presented in the book, What is Justice.
- 2.(Social Studies) Understand the challenges that emerged during Korea's economic growth and the efforts to solve them, as presented in the economics unit.

#### 5) Lesson Introduction

- 1. Activity Details & Materials:
- Exaggerated action and explanation is needed so that the students can fully immerse themselves in the given situation.
- Describe the situation using PPT slides and organize the students into groups of 3, and have them select roles in an appropriate manner (ex. Rock-paper-scissors).

\*Duration: 5 Minutes

#### TV Show 'Law of Survival'

This island is a mysterious island where no one has lived for 3,000 years.

Now you have to play either Role A, B or C and survive on this island for a month.

Food must be obtained directly from the "Mysterious Tree" and "Legendary Well" on the island.

Discussion will be made to determine how to share the food. Let's begin the show!

# Students select roles through rock-paper-scissors





A Strong, fast and shows very good physical ability



B Normal build, shows average physical ability



C Has very poor physical ability compared to other players

#### 6) Lesson Development

#### 1. Activity Details & Materials:

- Conduct Activity 1 (Apple Game+ Discussion) and Activity 2 (Fish Game + Discussion).
- Minimize teacher's intervention during the activity or its outcome so that students can freely express their thoughts and feelings.

\*Duration: 65 Minutes

### Activity 1(Sharing Apples)

- Understand how to get the apples as according to the chosen role in the group (3 students)
- Play the game in the order of A, B, C, each given 20 seconds to go get the apples.
- (Organize your thoughts 1) Individually think about what is the most desirable way to share the apples.
- (Organize your thoughts 2) Discuss among the group members on what is the most desirable way to share the apples.
  - Compare individual thoughts with the thought of the group.

#### Activity 2(Sharing Fish)

- Form a group (Village A, B, C) with students playing the same role.
- Select a leader of each village.
- The teacher adjusts the location of the well (where fish can be caught) in the order of Village A, Village B and Village C.
- Begin the game of moving the fish to the village storage.
- (Organize your thoughts 1) Individually think about what is the most desirable way to share the fish.
- (Organize your thoughts2) Discuss with the village members on what is the most desirable way to share the fish.
- (Organize your thoughts 3) The village representatives discuss and decide what is the most desirable way to share the fish.

3) Lesson Goals: Students can understand and sympathize with the socially disadvantaged and the discriminatory situations they face through role-playing.

#### 4) Prior Activities:

- 1.(Korean-Whole Book Reading) Have a discussion on meritocracy as presented in the book, What is Justice.
  - 2.(Social Studies) Understand the challenges that emerged during Korea's economic growth and the efforts to solve them, as presented in the economics unit.



### Example 3.

"I could understand how a social minority teels after I played the role of Person C., I think it's weird that you can share the apples with the team members (Activity 1) but cannot share the fish with the villagers (Activity 2)"

- 10) Follow-up Activities
- 1.Explore some 'social mechanisms' that considers the social minority
- 2.Look for such 'social mechanisms' in our neighborhood and the school

- Share the apples evenly among the group members






3 Share few apples to the person with the least number of apples

Form a village with peers of the same role and select a chief villager





# ABOUT THE GAME

Take the fish back to the village as according to the role

Move the fish from 2m away

Move the fish from 4m away

Move the fish from 6m away

Organize your thoughts

### (How to share the fish)

- 1 Share the fish among your villagers only
- 2 Collect the fish from all the people and share it evenly among the villages
- 3 The first two villages with the most number of fish share it with the village with the least number of fish



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
