

What do you think are the causes of road accidents? Road traffic accidents, injuries, and deaths are considered a global problem. According to WHO (2018), 1.35 million people are killed on roadways around the world each year. The UN General Assembly mandated WHO and the UN regional commissions to plan and host periodic UN Global Road Safety Weeks.

In 2020, the UN General Assembly proclaimed the Decade of Action for Road Safety 2021-2030 to prevent at least 50% of road traffic deaths and injuries by 2030. It brings together individuals, governments, NGOs, corporations, and other organizations from around the world to raise awareness of road safety and make changes that will reduce the number of road deaths.
